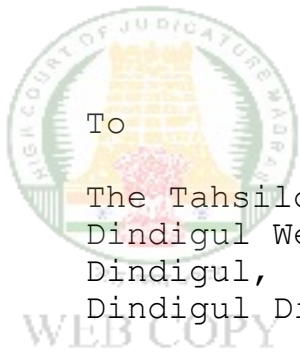
'I may be pleased to withdraw this writ petition'.
