PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

for Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.165 of 2019 on the file of
the Respondent Police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and
the Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent.

2.The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the
respondent for the offence under Section 379 of IPC in Crime No.165
of 2019.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) submitted that
the petitioner had cut the jack fruit trees that belong to the
Government and committed the offences in question and the petitioner
left the properties at the place of occurrence.



4.Considering the nature of allegation, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Kuzhithurai and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

5.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
