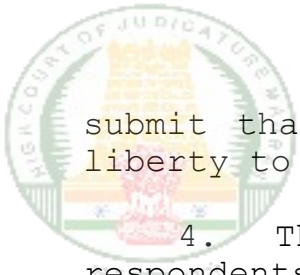
ORDER

In view of the above, without going into the merits of the petitioner's case, the petitioner is directed to submit a fresh representation by enclosing relevant documents along with a copy of this order to the respondents within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. On such receipt, the second respondent is directed to consider the same and pass appropriate order on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as all the interested parties, if there are no other legal impediments, within a period of four weeks thereafter.

6. The Writ Petition stands disposed of with the above direction. No costs.
