PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory bail in Crime No.92/2019 on the file of the respondent police .

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent Police for the offence under Section 379 of IPC and 21(1) of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957, in Crime No.92 of 2019. He seeks anticipatory bail.

2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent Police.

3.The petitioner's counsel submitted that the petitioner is having one previous case of the same nature.

4.In this case, even though there was some illegal quarrying, there was no actual transportation of the quarried mineral.



5. Taking note of the facts and circumstances of this case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Paramakudi, Ramanthapuram District and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

5. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
