PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

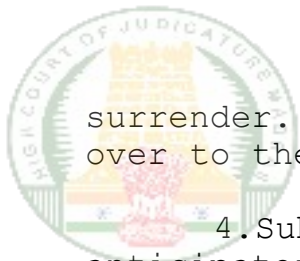
PRAYER :-For Anticipatory bail in Crime No. 10 /2019 on the file of the respondent police .

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2.The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 120 B and 420 IPC I.P.C., in Crime No.10 of 2019 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

3.The case against the petitioner rests on documentary evidence. The petitioner's counsel without prejudice to his contention offers to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- directly to the defacto complainant. He seeks time to do so. The petitioner is directed to take a Demand Draft for a sum of Rs.50,000/- favoring the defacto complainant and deposit the same at the time of



surrender. On such deposit, the said demand draft shall be handed over to the defacto complainant by the court below.

4. Subject to the aforesaid condition, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate Court No.I, Karur and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

5. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
