PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.177 of 2019 on the file of the respondent.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under section 379 of I.P.C., and Section 21(4) of Mines and Minerals Development and Regulation Act 1957, in Crime No.177 of 2019 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

3. The quantity involved is one unit of red sand. The learned

shall deposit a sum of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand Only) as non-refundable deposit to the concerned District Mineral Foundation Trust.

4. Recording the said undertaking given by the petitioner's counsel, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Principal District Judge, Theni, and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

5. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
