PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

2.The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 366(A) and 506(i) of I.P.C., and Section 9 and 10 of Prohibition of Child Marriage, 2006, and 5(1), 6 of POSCO Act, 2012 and 147, 148, 323, 324, 506(ii) of IPC and 363 of IPC in Crime No.193 of 2019 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

3.The primary allegations are only against the husband of the defacto complainant with whom she is said to have got married under the coercive circumstances. By arresting the petitioners herein, no purpose will be served. A1 is still in custody.

4. In view of the above, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Session Mahila Court, Madurai, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only)each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

5. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
