PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.13 of 2019 on the file of the
Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the
learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the
respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 498(A),
294(b) and 506(i) of I.P.C., in Crime No.13 of 2019 on the file of
the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

3. The petitioner is figuring as accused No.1. He is the
husband of the defacto complainant. The co-accused were already
granted anticipatory bail. The petitioner undertakes to pay a sum of
Rs.3,000/- to the defacto complainant.

4. The petitioner will ascertain the bank account details of
the defacto complainant and deposit the amount in question on or
before 20th of every month. The petitioner's liability will commence

from this month onwards. This is only an interim arrangement and without prejudice to the rights of the defacto complainant. This order would abide by the final order that may be passed by the jurisdictional civil Court or the family Court.

5. Recording the said undertaking, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Palani, and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
