PRAYER :-

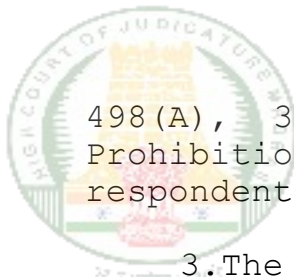
for Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.8 of 2019 on the file of the

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the
learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2.The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the
respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b),

498(A), 323, 506(ii), 406 of I.P.C. and Section 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, in Crime No.8 of 2019, on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

3.The first petitioner is the husband and he got married to the defacto complainant in the year 2009. Two children were born through the wedlock.

4.The learned counsel for the petitioners, on instructions, states that the first petitioner would pay a sum of Rs.7,000/- as monthly maintenance to the defacto complainant. The mode of payment can be worked out accordingly. This is only an interim arrangement and it would abide by the orders to be passed by the Jurisdictional Family Court / Family Magistrate Court. The first petitioner is said to be a Government Servant who is also a physically challenged person and suffering 60% disability in both legs.

5.Recording the undertaking given by the first petitioner, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate Court No.IV, Tirunelveli, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

6.The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
