5.With the above observations, Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.

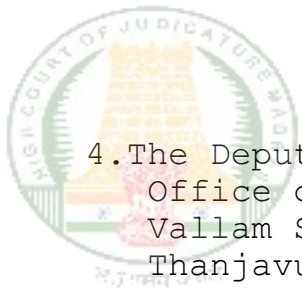
