PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 304 of 2019 on the file of the Respondent Police.

**ORDER :** The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences under sections 454 and 380 of I.P.C., in Crime No.304 of 2019, seeks anticipatory bail.

3.The case of the defacto complainant is that the petitioner along with A1 entered his jewellery shop and committed theft of the



items in question. A1 was arrested and the stolen jewellery was recovered. The involvement of the petitioner came to light after viewing the CCTV footage. In view of the role played by the petitioner, she is not entitled to anticipatory bail. Hence, the criminal original petition stands dismissed.
