PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.439 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

for Bail in Crime No.284 of 2019 on the file of the respondent police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner is figuring as accused No.10. The petitioner is in custody since 21.06.2019 for the offences punishable under sections 147, 148, 341 and 302 of I.P.C. @ 147, 148, 149, 341, 302, 120(b) and r/w 114 of I.P.C. and Section 27(3) of Arms Act in Crime No. 284 of 2019 on the file of the respondent police. He seeks bail.

3. The learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) submitted that 88 days are over and investigation appears to be almost completed. This Court had already granted bail to the co-accused/A-6.



4. Taking note of these facts, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to the following conditions;

(i) the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.VI, Madurai.

(ii) the petitioner is directed to appear before the respondent police as and when required for the interrogation.

(iii) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].
