Prayer: Contempt Petition is filed under Section 11 of Contempt of Courts Act, to commit and punish the respondents for contempt of Court for willfully and wantonly disobeyed the order passed by this Court in W.P.(MD)No.8684 of 2019, dated 11.04.2019.

Prayer in WP(MD) . 8684 of 2019 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court To issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to compute and pay the petitioners entire eligible terminal benefits payable to him including provident Fund, Gratuity, Commuted value of Pension and Terminal Leave Salary together with interest at the rate of 18% per annum from the date of his retirement to till the date of payment.
