PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 161 of 2019 on the file of
the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the
learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the
respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 294(b),
323, 324 and 506(ii) of I.P.C., in Crime No.161 of 2019 on the file
of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

3. Serious allegations have been made only against the second
petitioner Prabhakaran. He is said to have caused fracture on the
leg to the defacto complainant. Taking note of this, this Criminal
Original petition stands dismissed as far as the second petitioner
is concerned. The second petitioner can only surrender and take a

4. I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to petitioners 1, 3 and 4 with certain conditions. Accordingly, petitioners 1, 3 and 4 are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Kovilpatti, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that petitioners 1, 3 and 4 shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. Petitioners 1, 3 and 4 shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

5. Petitioners 1, 3 and 4 shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.

6. With this observation, this Criminal Original petition stands partly allowed.
