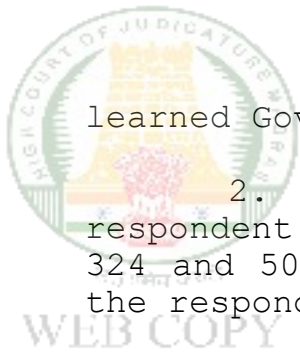
PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences under sections 147, 294(b), 323, 324 and 506(ii) of I.P.C., in Crime No.158 of 2019, on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

3. The primary allegations are against Rathinasamy. He is said to have been arrested and released on bail also.

4.The petitioners' counsel submitted that a counter case has also been registered against the defacto complainant.

5.The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) submitted that the petitioners are not having any previous case.

6. Taking note of all these aspects, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.VI, Tiruchirappalli, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

6. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
