PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

for Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.39 of 2019 on the file of the
Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the
learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2.The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the
respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 417,
420, 463, 465, 468, 471 and 109 of I.P.C., in Crime No.39 of 2019,
on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

3.The petitioner was the Manager of the defacto complainant
bank. The petitioner appears to have given loan even without
obtaining a proper security. The principal accused have been granted
relief of bail, as they have paid the amount under one time
settlement. But the fact remains that the defacto complainant bank
has been put to a huge loss. In any event, the case against the

petitioner rests on documentary evidence. Therefore, the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not necessary.

4.Taking note of the facts and circumstances, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Trichy, and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of two weeks and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

5.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
