Prayer in HCP(MD) . No.10 of 2014:

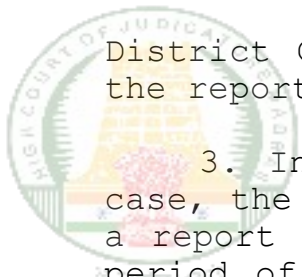
