(Order of the Court was made by T.RAJA., J)

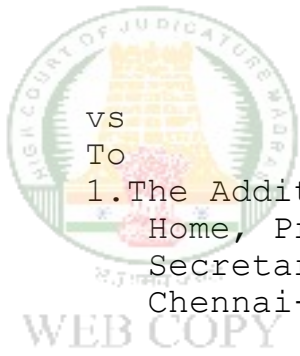
