PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records pertaining to the impugned long term promotion policy of the third respondent in Memo No.27/2012 dated 02.05.2012 and quash the same as illegal, arbitrary and unconstitutional as far as it contrary to the mandatory guidelines issued by the respondents 1 and 2 and further call for the records pertaining to the consequent impugned promotion order in Memo No.50/2014, dated 22.05.2014 passed by the third respondent and quash the same as illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional as far as the non-inclusion of the petitioner in it and consequently, direct the third respondent to consider the petitioner for promotion from Scale III to IV duly following the



long term promotion policy of the third respondent in light of the mandatory guidelines circulated by the respondents 1 and 2 from time to time.
