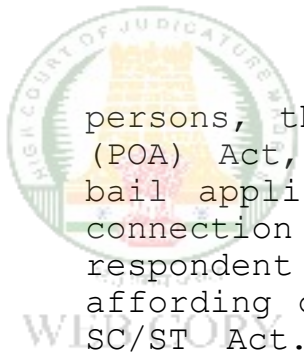




persons, there shall be a direction to the Special Court of SC/ST (POA) Act, Sessions Judge, Dindigul, to consider the petitioner's bail application, preferably on the same day of his surrender in connection with Crime No. 244 of 2019 on the file of the 2nd respondent and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law after affording due opportunity to the victim under Section 15(a) of the SC/ST Act. The petitioner shall surrender before the concerned jurisdictional Court within a period of fifteen days from the date of the receipt of a copy of this Order.

3. In view of the above, the Criminal Original Petition stands allowed.
