The learned Counsel for the writ petitioner made a submission that the writ petitioner has received all the benefits and accordingly, his grievances are redressed.

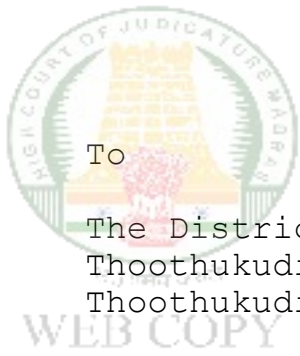
2.Thus, the writ petition stands disposed of as infructuous. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
