Petition praying that in the circumstances stated therein and in the affidavit filed therewith the High Court will be pleased to dispense with personal appearance of the petitioner/Respondent namely "Mangat Ram Sharma, The Secretary to Government, Department of Higher Education, Fort St.George, Chennai" on 19.09.2019 in the Contempt Petition (MD)No.753 of 2019 in WP(MD)No.4866 of 2019 and thus render justice.

PRAYER IN CONT P(MD) No.753 of 2019:

Petition praying that in the circumstances stated therein and in the affidavit filed therewith the High Court will be pleased



to initiate contempt proceedings against the Contemnors/Respondents to punish him for the wilful disobedience of the order of this Honourable Madurai Bench of Madras High Court in W.P.(MD)No.4866 of 2019 dated 25.03.2019 and thus render justice.

PRAYER IN WP(MD) . No.4866 of 2019:-

Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Mandamus, to direct the respondents to permit the petitioner to fill up the sanctioned vacancies of the Teaching Staff, namely, (1 Assistant Professor in English, 1 Assistant Professor in Tamil, 1 Assistant Professor in Hindi, 3 Assistant Professors in History, 4 Assistant Professor in Economics, 2 Assistant Professors in B.B.A., 4 Assistant Professors in Maths, 2 Assistant Professors in Chemistry, 4 Assistant Professor in Botany, 6 Assistant Professors in Zoology, 5 Assistant Professor in Geology and 5 Assistant Professors in Commerce) and the Non-teaching staff namely, (1 Junior Assistants, 1 Steno-Typist, 1 Record Clerk, 2 Museum keeper, 4 Lab Assistants, 8 Office Assistants, 2 Watchmen, 5 Sweeper, 1 Gardner, 2 Waterman, 1 Herbarium Keeper, 1 Library Assistant) and consequently, to release the grant-in-aid to the petitioner college within the time frame stipulated by this Court.

ORDER : This petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of MR.K.CHELLAPANDIAN, Additional Advocate General for the petitioner and of MR.T.LAJAPATHI ROY, Advocate on behalf of the Respondents the court made the following order:-
