4. Following the said order, this writ petition is dismissed and the petitioner is granted eight weeks time to comply with the direction contained in the impugned notice, failing which, it is



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open to the respondent to take appropriate action to evict the Petitioner from the subject place, in the manner known to law. No costs. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petitions are dismissed.
