ORDER

2. The learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) would submit that on the complaint First Information Report has been registered in Crime No.100 of 2019 for the offence under Section 174 Cr.P.C. It is a case of hit and run and now they got details from toll gate and other nearby eye witnesses in respect of vehicle. Further they are about to complete the investigation.

3. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, at this stage transfer of investigation would not serve any purpose as alleged by the petitioner. Hence this petition is dismissed. However the third respondent police is directed to complete the investigation and file final report within a period of twelve weeks



from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Further the second respondent is directed to monitor the investigation done by the third respondent and shall ensure that the third respondent shall complete the investigation as directed by this Court.
