PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent to settle the petitioner's retirement benefits including monthly pension, provident fund, gratuity and earned leave wages for 65.5 days payable with settlement dated 01.09.2016 under Section 12(3) of ID Act, 1947, payable to the petitioner with 16% rate of interest within the time that may be stipulated by this Court.

3.This Writ Petition is filed for a direction to the respondent to settle the petitioner's retirement benefits, including monthly pension, provident fund, gratuity and earned leave wages for 65 ½ days, payable with settlement, dated 01.09.2016, under Section 12(3) of ID Act, 1947, payable to the petitioner with 16% interest.

4.According to the petitioner, he was working as Conductor from 29.01.1999 in the respondent Corporation and retired from service on 31.07.2019. The grievance of the petitioner is that the respondent has not settled the retirement benefits, including monthly pension, provident fund, gratuity and earned leave wages for
