ORDER

The relief sought for in the present writ petition is to forbear the respondents from terminating the services of the petitioner without due process of law.

However, the second respondent is District Blindness Control Society, which is a scheme formulated by the Government and the scheme is functioning under a separate fund and the employees engaged on daily wage basis are not the employees of the Government.
