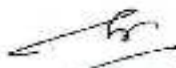


ORDER

Learned State counsel has placed before this Court written instructions, which reads as follows:

POSITION NOTES IN W.P.(MD).NO.20784 OF 2019

1. I am to state that Minor. Swathika S.K has joined BCS seat at the Tamil Nadu Government Dental College & Hospital, Chennai on 11.07.2019. She has discontinued the course on 14.06.2019, the discontinuation fee of Rs. 10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs only) to the Director of Medical Education vide L.Dis.No.65747 ME II/2/2019 by remitting.
2. The Director of Medical Education in their letter L.Dis.No.8844/ME2/2/2019 dated 13.11.2019 has permitted to return the Discontinuation fee amount of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs only) to Minor S.K. Swathika, as it will be refunded on or before Nov 20th of 2019.
