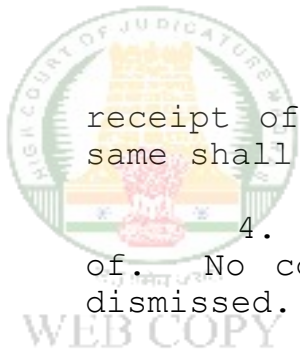
ORDER

Heard Mr.T.Lajapathi Roy, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.T.S.Mohammed Mohideen, learned Standing Counsel, for the respondents. By consent on either side, this writ petition is taken up for final disposal.

2. The petitioner has challenged the order passed by the second respondent. Admittedly, as against the order passed by the second respondent, the petitioner has an effective alternative remedy by way of an appeal to the High Court. Therefore we are of the firm view that the petitioner should not bypass the appeal remedy and should avail the same as the remedy is not only effective but also efficacious.

3. Therefore, we direct the petitioner to file an appeal to the High Court, within a period of thirty days from the date of



receipt of a copy of this order and if such appeal is filed, the same shall be considered in accordance with law.

4. With the above direction, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is dismissed.
