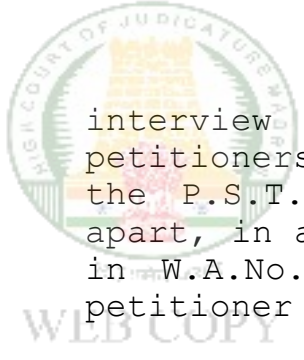

When the matter was taken up for hearing, the learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioners made a submission that the last date of selection for the post of Assistant was 09.02.2011 and the



interview was held from June to July, 2012. However, the writ petitioners could not be able to secure the relevant certificates to avail the P.S.T.M.Quota from the University only on 19.11.2012. This apart, in a similar case, this Court, vide Judgment dated 07.11.2014 in W.A.No.408 of 2014, has rejected the claim of the writ petitioner therein.

2. This being the factum, the writ petitioners have not established the grievances warranting an interference by this Court and hence, no further adjudication is required in respect of the grounds raised in the present writ petitions. Accordingly, the writ petitions stand closed. No costs.
