ORDER:- Criminal Original Petition coming up for hearing on this day and upon perusing the earlier order of this Court and the requisition letter submitted by the Judicial Magistrate, Aruppukottai, in D.No.490/2020 dated 24.06.2020 and none appearing for both sides, this Court made the following order:
