3.After elaborate arguments, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that if a direction is issued to the second respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 10.01.2019, on merits, the petitioner would be satisfied.



4.Considering the aforesaid submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, without deciding the issues on merits, this Court directs the second respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 10.01.2019, on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5.With the above direction, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs.
