2. The grievance of the petitioner is that, she married one Vijayakumar, who belongs to Hindu Arundhathiyar Community. Now, the parents of the petitioner are giving life threat to them. Hence, she made a representation to give police protection. That was not considered so far. Hence, the present Writ Petition has been filed.



3. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) appearing for the first and second respondents, on instructions, submitted that based on the petitioner's complaint, enquiry has been conducted and now, it is closed.

4. Considering the fact that based on the complaint given by the petitioner, enquiry has been conducted and thereafter, the complaint has been closed, no further order is required to be passed in the present Writ Petition. Hence, the Writ Petition is dismissed. No costs.
