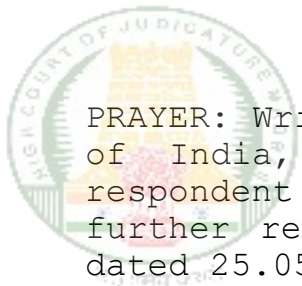

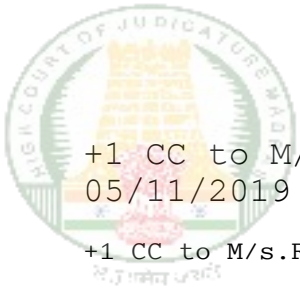
5. In view of the same, the writ petition is dismissed. No costs. It is open to the petitioner to challenge the rejection order dated 14.05.2018.
