PRAYER IN AS(MD) No.SR18966 of 2018:

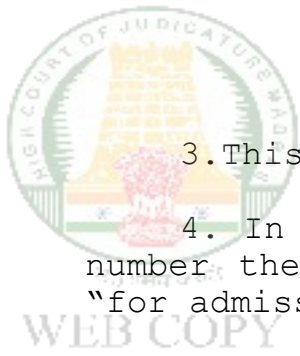
