S.C.No.9 of 2019.

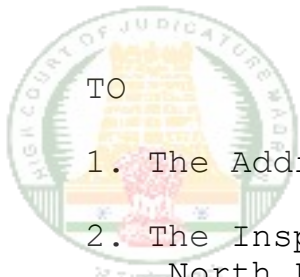
