ORDER

Mr.B.Muthukarthikeyan, learned counsel on record for writ petitioner is before this Court.

2. Mr.Aayiram K.Selvakumar, learned Additional Government Pleader, accepts notice on behalf of sole respondent.

3. With consent of learned counsel on both sides, main writ petition is taken up, heard out and is being disposed of.

The main writ petition turns on a very narrow compass, as it is one seeking mandamus qua disposal of writ petitioner's representation dated 13.08.2019 wherein writ petitioner has made a request for measuring, surveying and fixing the boundaries for lands, which according to writ petitioner belongs to him. The writ petitioner undertakes to pay necessary fees and charges, if not already paid.

Notwithstanding several averments made in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, notwithstanding several grounds raised / contentions urged in the affidavit filed in support of instant writ petition, learned counsel for writ petitioner abridges the scope of the writ petition and submits that it will suffice if the respondent is directed to dispose of the
