Prayer in WP(MD). 20709 of 2018 :

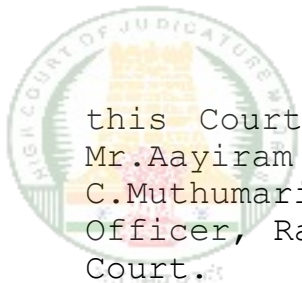
Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, to call for the records of the 1st Respondents impugned order RA.5(1)/15722/2018 (E.A.No.01/2018) dated 13.09.2018 and quash the same as it devoid of merits and direct the 1st Respondent to give suitable recommendation to the 4th respondent to consider the change of address and renewal of licence No.4/2010 for the retail sale of fireworks and crackers for his new premises at Door No.6/315-A Lenin Street, Paramakudi Taluk, Ramanathapuram District by considering petitioner's representation dated 24.03.2017 within the stipulated period as fixed by this Court.
