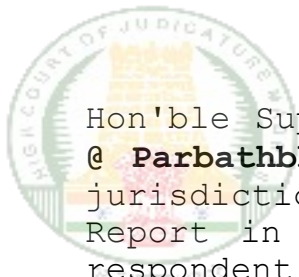
ORDER

The Criminal Original Petition has been filed to quash the proceedings in Crime No.130 of 2019 on the file of the first respondent Police for the alleged offences under Sections 341, 294 (b), 352, 307 and 506(ii) of IPC.

2.The case is still at the stage of investigation. By passage of time, the parties have decided to bury their hatchet and compromise the dispute amicably among themselves.

3.A Joint Memo of Compromise has been filed before this Court which have been signed by the petitioner and the second respondent and also by their respective counsel. The petitioner and the second respondent were also present in person before this Court and they were identified by Mr.Aamini, Special Sub-Inspector of Police. This Court also enquired both the parties and was satisfied that the parties have come to an amicable settlement between themselves.

4.Under such circumstances, no useful purpose will be served in keeping the First Information Report pending before the first respondent police. Even though, the offences involved are not compoundable in nature. In the light of the guidelines given by the



Hon'ble Supreme Court reported in 2017 9 **SCC 641-(Parbathbhai Aahir @ Parbathbhai Vs. State of Gujrat)**, this Court in exercise of its jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C. quashes the First Information Report in Crime No.130 of 2019 pending on the file of the first respondent police.

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5.This Criminal Original Petition stands allowed and as a sequel, the proceedings in Crime No.130 of 2019, on the file of the first respondent police, is quashed and the terms of joint compromise memo shall form part and parcel of this order. The petitioners shall pay a sum of Rs.5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) as costs, to the credit of the Chief Justice Relief Fund (payable in Accounts Section of the High Court Registry), within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and file a photocopy of the receipt along with a memo reporting compliance in the Registry and further directed to pay a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) to the second respondent herein within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
