PRAYER: This Criminal Original Petition has been filed under Section 482 of Criminal Procedure Code, to quash the charge sheet filed by the first respondent police in Spl.S.C.No.67 of 2018 on the file of the Magalir Neethimandram-Fast Track Mahila Court, Thoothukudi.

O R D E R

The Criminal Original Petition has been filed to quash the proceedings in Spl.S.C.No.67 of 2018 on the file of the Magalir Neethimandram-Fast Track Mahila Court, Thoothukudi.

2.The case is still at the stage of trial. By passage of time, the parties have decided to bury their hatchet and compromise the dispute amicably among themselves.

3.A Joint Memo of Compromise has been filed before this Court which have been signed by the petitioner and the second respondent and also by their respective counsel. The petitioner and the second



respondent were also present in person before this Court. This Court also enquired both the parties and was satisfied that the parties have come to an amicable settlement between themselves.

4.Under such circumstances, no useful purpose will be served in keeping the proceedings is pending before the Magalir Neethimandram-Fast Track Mahila Court, Thoothukudi. Even though, the offences involved are not compoundable in nature. In the light of the guidelines given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court reported in (2017) 9 SCC 641-(Parbathbhai Aahir @ Parbathbhai Vs. State of Gujrath), this Court in exercise of its jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C. quashes the proceedings in Spl.S.C.No.67 of 2018 on the file of the Magalir Neethimandram-Fast Track Mahila Court, Thoothukudi.

5.This Criminal Original Petition stands allowed and as a sequel, the proceedings in Spl.S.C.No.67 of 2018 on the file of the Magalir Neethimandram-Fast Track Mahila Court, Thoothukudi, is quashed and the terms of Joint Compromise memo shall form part and parcel of this order. The petitioner shall pay a sum of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) as costs, to the credit of the Chief Justice Relief Fund (payable in Accounts Section of the High Court Registry), and file a photocopy of the receipt along with a memo reporting compliance before the Registry / first respondent and the trial Court on or before 19.11.2019, failing which, this order automatically stands cancelled without further reference to this Court and the trial Court can proceed with the trial in Spl.S.C.No.67 of 2018.

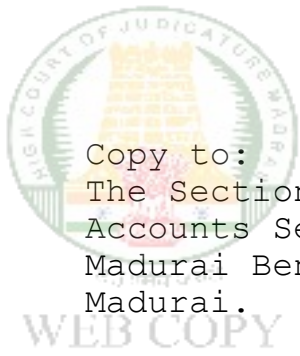
