



offences involved are not compoundable in nature. In the light of the guidelines given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court reported in 2017 9 SCC 641-(Parbathbhai Aahir @ Parbathbhai Vs. State of Gujrath), this Court in exercise of its jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C. quashes the proceedings in C.C.No.313 of 2015

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5.This Criminal Original Petition stands allowed and as a sequel, the proceedings in C.C.No.313 of 2015 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Sivagiri, is quashed and the terms of joint compromise memo shall form part and parcel of this order. The petitioner shall pay a sum of Rs.5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) as costs, to the credit of the Chief Justice Relief Fund (payable in Accounts Section of the High Court Registry), and file a photocopy of the receipt along with the memo reporting compliance before the Registry/1st respondent and the trial court on or before 21.11.2019, failing which, this order automatically stands cancelled without further reference to this Court and the trial court can proceed with the trial in C.C.No.313 of 2015.
