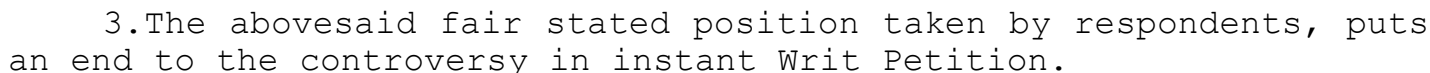

4. Learned counsel for writ petitioner highlights one aspect of the matter. It is submitted that lectures commenced on 30th September, 2019 and writ petitioner has not been able to attend lectures from 05.11.2019 owing to re-allotment to Ramanathapuram College vide impugned order.

5. This Court is also informed that writ petitioner can join Dr. Ambedkar Government Law College, Pattaraiperumpudhur from tomorrow i.e., 19.11.2019. Therefore, writ petitioner not having attended lectures from 05.11.2019 to this day i.e., 18.11.2019, shall remain condoned and shall not be put against writ petitioner while computing requisite attendance for examinations or any other purposes in future.

6. Instant Writ Petition is disposed of recording the aforesaid written instructions of the respondents. No costs. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petitions are closed.
