PRAYER:- Writ Petition - filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent to indicate the petitioner as the cultivating Tenant in the Patta No.2275 for the lands bearing S.Nos.51/7,52/1, 52/3A and in the patta No.974 for the land bearing S.No.49/1 situate at Urappanur I Bit, Thirumangalam Tk, Madurai District as per the Rule 6 of Tamil nadu Patta Pass Book Rules 1987 in Tamil Nadu Patta Pass Book Act, 1983 based on his representation dated 24.10.2019 made to the respondent herein.

ORDER
