2. With consent of learned counsel on both sides, main writ petition is taken up, heard out and is being disposed of.

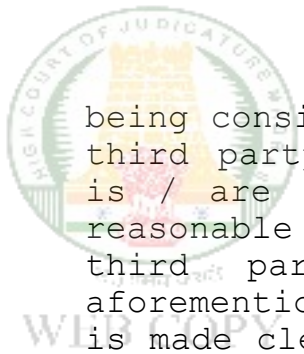
3. The main writ petition turns on a very narrow compass, as it is one seeking mandamus qua disposal of writ petitioner's representation dated 31.10.2019 wherein writ petitioner has sought measurement, survey and fixing of boundaries of land or in other

6. The aforesaid representation dated 31.10.2019 shall be disposed of by the first respondent on its own merits and in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible and in any event, within a period of eight (8) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

being considered by the first respondent, if the rights of any other third party / parties or any other third party entity / entities is / are likely to be affected, the first respondent shall give reasonable opportunity to such third party / parties or any other third party entity / entities, before disposing of the aforementioned writ petitioner's representation. Though obvious, it is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion or view on the merits of the matter. The authority concerned shall not embark upon any exercise which is within the domain of civil Court jurisdiction.

8. The proceeding / order of disposal shall be communicated by the office of the first respondent to the writ petitioner and others concerned (if any) under due acknowledgement within seven (7) working days from the completion of aforesaid exercise.

9. Instant Writ Petition is disposed of with the above directions. No costs.
