PRAYER:- Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to survey and lay boundary stones in the petitioner's land in S.F.No.13/1 in Patta No.1918 with an extent of 0.96.50 Ares situate in Vijayapuram Village, Kulathupatti Group, Singampunari Taluk, Sivagangai District in accordance with Tamil Nadu Survey and Boundary Act, 1920 by considering the petitioner's representation dated 26.06.2019 within a stipulated time as fixed by this Court.
