PRAYER:- Writ Petition - filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the 3rd and 4th respondents herein to cancel the patta Nos. 26, 200 in respect of survey Nos. 84/9A, 9B to an extent of 2.10 Acres in Sengudi Village, Sengudi Post, R.S. Mangalam Taluk, Ramanathapuram District by considering the petitioner's representation dated 13.05.2019 and consequently directing the 5th respondent to conduct the enquiry as against the respondents 6 to 8 in respect of the property in Survey Nos. 84/9A, 9B to an extent of 2.10 Acres in Sengudi Village, Sengudi Post, R.S. Mangalam Taluk, Ramanathapuram District, which was pledged by the respondents 6 to 8 by fabricating the documents and obtained loan from 5th respondent herein.

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ORDER
