O R D E R

This quash petition is filed to quash the criminal proceedings in C.C. No.189 of 2016 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Nilakkottai, Dindigul District for the offences under Sections 143, 145, 341, 188, 285 of IPC, as against the petitioners.

2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners would submit that the facts of the case are exactly similar to the case covered in the decision reported in **2018 2 LW (Cr1) 606 [Jeevanandham and others vs. The Inspector of Police Velayuthampalayam Police Station, Karur District] dated 20.09.2018** and in the case of **Sri Raja vs Inspector of Police, Sivakasi Town Police Station Virudhunagar District and others** in batch of cases in **Crl.O.P(MD) No.7922 of 2019 dated 30.08.2019**

3. The learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police would submit that the facts of the case are similar to the facts covered under the Judgment referred above.

4.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police.

5. Perused the material records available on record.

6.The facts of this case is similar to the facts covered by the Judgment of this Court reported in **2018 2 LW (Cr1) 606 [Jeevanandham and others vs. The Inspector of Police Velayuthampalayam Police Station, Karur District] dated 20.09.2018** and in case of **Sri Raja vs Inspector of Police, Sivakasi Town Police Station Virudhunagar District and others** in batch of cases in **Crl.O.P(MD) No.7922 of 2019 dated 30.08.2019**. Accordingly, the proceedings in C.C. No. 189 of 2016 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Nilakottai, Dindigul District is hereby quashed insofar as the petitioners are concerned and the Criminal Original Petition is allowed. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
