3. Hence this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.

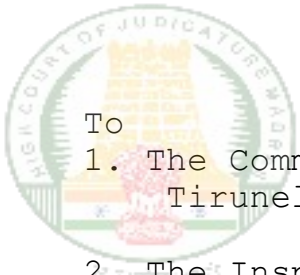
