PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 35/2019 on the file of the Respondent Police.

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences under section 379 of I.P.C., in Crime No.35 of 2019, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

3. It is a case involving theft of copper wire. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) states that the petitioner has been
