**ORDER**

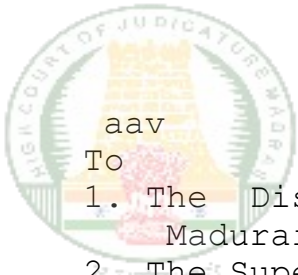
