PRAYER :-

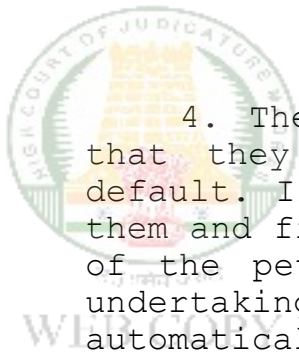
For Anticipatory Bail in Cr.No.100 of 2014 on the file of the respondent.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioners are shown as accused in S.T.C.No.38 of 2016, on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Ramanathapuram, for the offences under Section 4A of Tamil Nadu Open Public Places Disfigurements Act.

3. The petitioners did not appear before the Court below on 21.06.2019, leading to issuance of NBW. The case is posted today ie., 20.12.2019 for hearing.



4. The petitioners through their counsel gives an undertaking that they will appear in all the future hearings without any default. If they are unable to appear, their counsel will represent them and file an application under Section 317 of Cr.P.C. On account of the petitioners' absence, trial will not be stalled. If this undertaking is breached, the order now passed will stand vacated automatically and the petitioners will be remanded to custody.

5. Recording the said undertaking given by the petitioners through their counsel, the petitioners are directed to appear before the Court below on the next hearing date and apply for recall of warrant. On such application is being filed, the Court below shall recall the warrant at the end of the day. Non Bailable Warrant shall be kept in abeyance till then.

6. The Criminal Original petition stands disposed of, on these terms.
